

Indo-US Fogarty Joint Workshop on Clinical Research Methods & Adolescent HIV-Update Ahmedabad, India, February 12-18, 2009

OBJECTIVE

The AIDS International Training and Research Program of the University of South Florida and Vadodra Medical College has created a Certificate Program in Clinical Research Methods, which is open to health care professionals from India who wish to strengthen their clinical research skills, in general, and particularly, in the area of Adolescent HIV/AIDS.

KEY TOPICS

This 7-day intensive training program will offer both didactic and hands-on training in the following modules. Literature Searching/Critical Literature Review, Scientific Writing, Scholarly Publication; Evidence Based Medicine, Clinical Research and Trials; Biostatistics in Clinical Designs. Interpretation of Study Findings (internal and external validity, applicability of findings; Ethical considerations in clinical research including IRB; Grant Proposal writing and grant management; Clinical research leadership and management; Special topics and project Development in diagnosis and management of adolescent HIV disease.

ELIGIBILITY:

A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution in science or its equivalent. Open to all Health Care Professionals specifically designed for MDs, PhDs or Nursing Professionals who are interested in clinical research.
