



ACET Councilors Nomination

Councilors are Deans or Nominees of the Dean of MCI Recognized Medical Colleges in India. Apart from regular meetings the Council meets at an annual assembly where the councilors are either renominated or replaced by their deans.

ACET Councilors are nominated on an annual basis. If renominated by their Dean the councilors need a Letter of Continuance from their Dean in addition to the Annual Assembly Fees and Filling of Registration Form.

Dean of the MCI Recognized Medical College will nominate a One Single Faculty to be ACET-COUNCILOR. Sitting Councilors can be renominated or stay on the council for two years without re-nomination.

- **The New Nominated Councilor must provide:**
 - Most recent Curriculum Vitae.
 - Passport Size Picture.
 - Completed Councilor Nomination Form.
 - Completed Registration Form and fees.
 - Support Letter from Dean of His or Her MCI Recognized Medical College

- **Broad Objectives of INDUS-EM Academic Council**
 - Facilitate the existing process for developing academic emergency medicine and Trauma care in India.
 - Start and sustain Academic Emergency Departments at their medical colleges.
 - Draw plans to start post graduate courses in Emergency Medicine by applying to the Medical Council of India.
 - Review past INDO-US-ACET Proceedings and chalk future directions.
 - Confirm guidelines for an Emergency Medicine and Trauma curriculum.
 - Explore opportunities to do an International Fellowship.
 - Explore future vistas for conducting International research.
 - Foster Faculty Development Programs started by Existing Councilors.
 - Create standardized protocols for Acute Pre-hospital, hospital and disaster care.
 - Create educational models for training medical students, residents, faculty, nurses and paramedical staff.
